- May delegate portions of structural design to structural designer(s) and oversee their performance.
- Perform structural observations of projects during construction and prepare letters documenting findings.
- Respond to questions during construction, both formally and informally.
- Provide guidance on structural system options to the architectural team during schematic design.
- Perform quality control review of projects designed by other structural leads.
- Maintain MWA, Inc. operations, quality and CAD standards relative to the structural design of the project.

Project Management

- Prepare strategic plans for project success.
- Manage structural design of multiple projects simultaneously during design and construction.
- Monitor structural design progress with respect to internal milestones, submittal deadlines, and project budgets.
